Our Park will be open to all static caravan owners.

On the latest advice from the government we have taken the decision to close all communal areas such as our bar, shop, reception and toilet/Shower block for the foreseeable future. The safety and wellbeing of everyone including our staff is a priority and we feel this move supports the recommendations by the government.

Anyone staying on site must follow the government guidelines including –

- . Washing hands for at least 20 seconds regularly.
- . Cover mouth and nose with tissue when coughing or sneezing and dispose of the tissue in the bin after use and then wash hands thoroughly
- . Avoid close contact with others on site including staff
- . If you have any of the symptoms please double bag your rubbish

If you have a persistent cough and/or high temperature please refrain from visiting woodlands for at least 14 days.

If you become unwell and have any symptoms whilst staying on site please do not approach anyone. Please self-isolate and follow government advice. Please call the office to let us know of your situation if you do become unwell.

If you wish to contact us it must be by telephone only. Please contact the office number between the hours of 10am – 4pm. If you wish to pay your bills or order a gas bottle please do so over the phone within office hours.

Our emergency contact number outside office hours is provided on the reception door.

At present the leisure club is open but we have made the decision to close our sauna and steam room.
