

## Amanda Winters Scholarship

### Overview

The Amanda Winters Scholarship Fund was established in memory of a Capital High School senior who lost her life in a tragic accident in 2013. Its purpose is to assist Capital High School graduating seniors in obtaining a higher education. Up to \$1,000 Award.

### Eligibility & Criteria

- Graduating senior from Capital High School
- Cumulative GPA between 3.0 and 3.5
- Demonstration of significant financial need
- Extracurricular Activities/Community Service: participation in school or volunteer activities that indicate a commitment to the community.

## Application Submission Guidelines/Instructions

Submit the following required information online:

### Profile Form

- Name, date of birth, address, etc.

### Personal Statement

- Write a statement indicating your reasons for wanting to pursue a post-secondary education, your intended course of study, and your future career goals. Include information that will show the Scholarship Selection Committee you are a strong candidate, e.g. outstanding attributes, talents, service to school or community, commitment to pursuing educational goals, motivation, and family circumstances.

(Minimum word count: 300)

### Two Letters of Recommendation

- Letters of Recommendation should remark on the applicant's overall character, achievement, and promise. At least one of the letters must be from a teacher, advisor, or administrator.

### Grade Transcript

- Most recent grade transcript. Unofficial are accepted.

### Student Aid Report (SAR)

- A completed SAR is used to determine your financial need. This document is returned to you when you complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). **Be certain that your report includes and EFC number.**
