

Collection Instruction – Megasteel Bluestem Warehouse

Megasteel will provide a unique reference number that must be given to the driver to authorise the collection.

The driver must give the unique reference number (in full) to the reception in the warehouse in order to collect the coils.

The driver must also provide the name of the customer, geographical area and the details of the load to be collected.

Without these details the collection will be refused.

Late arrival for collection will not be permitted.

The opening hours are:

8.30am to 5pm with the last arrival for loading at 4pm (unless agreed prior to arrival)

All of our Warehouses operate a strict **NO SMOKING** policy anywhere on the site – (including inside the driver's cab)

It is a requirement for drivers collecting goods to wear high visibility jacket/vest & safety shoes/boots.

Drivers reporting without this equipment will be refused entry to the site.

Overleaf, there is a map (the warehouse is the red pin). There is signage on the gates of the warehouse, but not yet on the building. Google Maps show us at 12 Bluestem Road, IP3 9RR. Search: Megasteel Ltd – warehouse.

Please advise your haulier, not to stop outside, as there is a very over-zealous traffic warden and CCTV cameras – <u>this could result in a fine</u>. There is also clear signage on lamp posts, stating no stopping!
