Students will enjoy learning these concepts through discussion and demonstration and they will practice executing flat and graduated washes. Students will learn the meaning and uses of color theory to enhance the depth of field in their paintings. Participants bring in images (with a strong light source) of subject matter that interests them, to develop a painting. Though Ms. Littleton focuses on wildlife painting in her own work, the realistic techniques she teaches are applicable for all subject matter including still life, landscape, figure, portrait and marine painting.

Create dynamic works of art using melted wax as you explore encaustic painting, a process that produces luminous and jewel-like surfaces and textures. Beginners as well as working artists are welcome! Demonstrations and experimentation allow students to learn techniques such as melting and fusing, line and edge, transfers, texture and collage. Students can choose to practice all of these methods or just the ones that interest them. Paint, equipment, and small practice panels will be supplied. Students may bring wood panels up to 9"x12" if they wish to make larger, more resolved works.

Watch how paint is physically moved around the canvas by the alcohol and how it creates unique and vibrant colors. You can also add multi-surface paint to achieve additional paint reactions. Practice and experiment with different colors and methods to create a finished piece or the start of a piece that can later be manipulated or built upon to create more resolved works. While the process is serendipitous, methods to affect the end result are also explored. No experience is required!

Please note: You will be provided with two 16"x20" canvases, please bring extra if you tend to work fast (canvases must be 16"x20" or smaller). All other materials are provided. Artwork will need to dry for at least 48 hours and be polymer sealed once dry. The instructor will let you know by email when your pieces are ready to be picked up, typically one week after the class.

The wax in the Cray-Pas will resist the watercolor and add interest and complexity to your piece. Also, learn how to manipulate the application of the watercolor to achieve different results. Then, apply a fixative and re-work certain areas to improve your piece. All materials will be provided.

Those interested in inviting a bit of chance into their works while expanding their technical skills and further developing their own aesthetic sense will enjoy this studio class. Demonstrations, individual instruction and discussion of works by contemporary and modern artists will help to inform each participant's creative process. Students provide most of their own supplies.
