Craft - Make our own Starry Night like Vincent Van Gogh

Starry Night is one of the most recognized pieces of art in the world. It is absolutely everywhere, too. 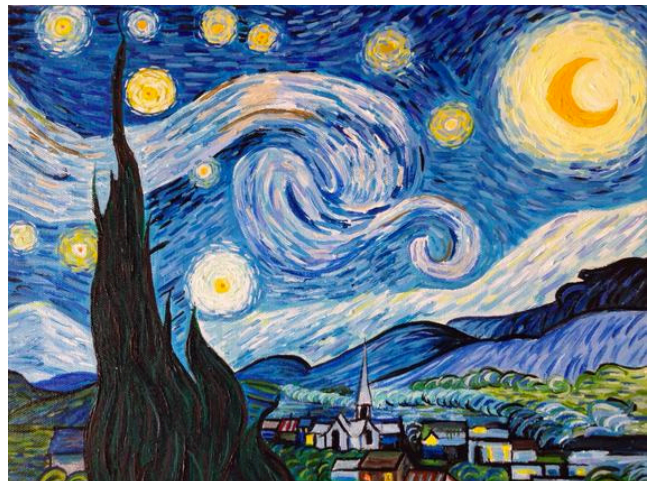

Materials:

- Watercolor Paper
- Crayons or Oil Pastels
- Watercolors (liquid, pan or tube watercolors)
- Salt
- Paint Brush

Directions:

1. Using a piece of watercolor paper, yellow and white oil pastels or crayons, mimic the swirls that you see in Van Gogh's Starry Night. You can also use a black oil pastel to draw the town at the bottom of the painting. This painting focuses a lot on the flow and direction of the paint strokes to create a sense of movement in the painting, so you will want to keep that in mind. Use yellow oil pastels to create the stars and moon, and feel free to add in any other elements to your painting to personalize it. Keep in mind that anywhere you put your oil pastel will repel any watercolor paint that you put on top.
1. Now start painting with your watercolors! Keep in mind that the more water you use the lighter your color will be. It is best to start painting in your light blue color first. Try to avoid the areas where you will want to put in other colors. After you get your light blue put in, begin to add in some darker blue by using less water. Then you can go over some areas with purple to create a little dimension.
2. Then you can paint in your stars or any other elements you added to your painting. If desired, and while the painting is still wet, you might want to sprinkle some table salt onto the sky part of your painting, it will create a starry looking bursting effect as the salt melts into the paint- just don't put too much!
