

Dear Patients & Visitors:

In response to COVID-19, Bridger Orthopedic and Rocky Mountain Surgical Center have implemented the following measures to help keep our patients and staff safe and healthy during this crisis:

- 1) All scheduled patients have been contacted via text, email, and phone and have been asked to reschedule if they experience any signs of illness or have been in contact with other people that are ill.
- 2) All employees of Bridger Orthopedic are required to adhere to Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and Montana Department of Public Health and Human Services (DPHHS) community mitigation strategies related to COVID-19.
- 3) All areas of our facilities are being sanitized multiple times daily with surgery center grade cleaning agents. Hand sanitizer is available for staff and patients all throughout our facilities.
- 4) Magazines and complimentary coffee and water have been removed from our waiting room and exam rooms.
- 5) We are asking that you limit the number of visitors attending your appointment to no more than one person.
- 6) To maximize social distancing within our organization, anyone able to perform their job from home is now doing. This has removed nearly 50 people from our facilities at any given time.
