— You heard the definition of justice as "relational righteousness," as putting right all relationships in life (*mishpat* and *tzadeqah*). What are ways **you** can pursue relational righteousness? Read aloud Job 29:12-17 and Isaiah 58:1-12 to spur some ideas.

— What are ways you can pray about God's heart for social justice, in your spheres of influence, our church family, and our city? Begin a list, and a plan for prayer.
