



SERMON GUIDE As you attend the worship service with your family, use this guide to help you pay attention and learn. We want you to worship by singing to GOD and listening to his Word preached.

OUTLINE

The main idea of today's sermon / "chapter" in our **UNITED** series: *Jesus cares about the justice of God.*

This is "chapter" 2 in the series, made up of three observations about Jesus —

One, Jesus is **himself** the expression of God's continuing alignment and identification with those who are suffering injustices, poor, oppressed, excluded, and disadvantaged —those on the outside looking in.

Two, Jesus identified his mission in Isaiahic terms of justice, with a concern for those who are close to the heart of God.

Three, Jesus supplies a surprising pathway to relational righteousness, as a way to grow more united.
