## <u>Continue the Conversation</u> – discuss these questions with others to continue applying today's message

- Jesus warns against what can derail us. Check yourself for -- peoplepleasing (fear of the opinions of others), greed, worry about money and material things, and religious acting (religious habits that are not the real me).
- Jesus calls and invites us to "count the cost" to make Him the center
  of how we do life. Check yourself for trusting and resting in the Father,
  knowing and gladly letting Him take care of your needs, and living for the
  finish line of standing before Him and being acknowledged by Him in the
