You may qualify for ASSISTANCE from the Department of Human Services for Child Care!

- 1) Who is eligible for child care assistance from the state?
 - Low-income working families
 - TANF clients in education, training, or other work-related activities approved by their caseworkers
 - Teen parents (under age 20) in elementary or high school, or a GED program
 - Low income families who are in school or training and are not receiving TANF cash assistance. (Must work at least 10 hours per week if they are in a college degree program.) Occupational vocational training, GED, ABE, ESL, and other below post-secondary education programs do not have a work requirement for the first 24 months. High school does not have a work requirement.
- 2) What does "low income" mean?

Your family's countable income must be below the following guidelines

<u>Family Size</u>	<u>Monthly Income Must Be Below</u>
2	\$2,334
3	\$2,934
4	\$3,534
5	\$4,134
6	\$4,734
7	\$5,334
8	\$5,934

To determine your countable income, the gross wages paid by an employer are added to your other income (such as any government benefits, child support you receive, or self employment income.) Any child support you pay is subtracted from your income.

- 3) Must I be the child's parent to qualify for the program?

No. A child's legal guardian or other relatives caring for the child are also eligible and should fill out an application form. Foster parents can receive child care assistance from the Department of Children and Family Services.
- 4) How old can the child be?

All children under age 13 are eligible. Children 13 or older are eligible if they are under court supervision or have written documentation from a medical provider stating that they are physically or mentally incapable of caring for themselves.

PREVENTION THROUGH EDUCATION TOPIC: BULLYING PREVENTION

On October 16, 2006, Tina Meier's life took a devastating turn when her 13 year old daughter, Megan Taylor Meier, took her own life.

Approximately 5 weeks prior to her passing, a 16 year old boy by the name of Josh Evans, contacted Megan through her MySpace account and they began a friendship. Tina Meier, allowed Megan to have a MySpace account with many restrictions and under her watchful eye. Unfortunately, on that fateful day of October 16, 2006, Josh Evans and Megan began to have an argument over MySpace. A few others joined in and horrible and hurtful messages and bulletins went out publicly to hundreds of kids. The last words that were said to Megan from Josh were, "The world would be a better place without you" and "Have a shi**y rest of your life."

Tina Meier was later informed that Josh Evans never existed. In fact, he was the fictitious creation of an adult neighbor named Lori Drew, her 13-year-old daughter Sarah (Megan's former friend), and an 18-year-old employee that worked out of Lori Drew's home.

Tina Meier reveals the story of her daughter Megan and shows first-hand the devastating effects of bullying & cyberbullying. Through Tina's inspirational and educational message, the audience develops an empathetic awareness and understanding of others and is empowered to make a difference; "TO BE THE CHANGE... TO BE MEGAN'S VOICE!"
