# the Studio at Hett Park



#### **Hett Park**

Hett Park, named in honor of Thomas A. Hett, is the latest addition to the North Berwyn Park District. Formerly Cuyler pool, Hett Park is home to Brocato playground, "the Studio" a new dance and fitness facility as well as a soon to be constructed water park.

Thomas A. Hett was instrumental in the formation of the North Berwyn Park District; Mr. Hett guided residents through the legalities of forming a new park district that ultimately led to the initiation of the North Berwyn Park District. Mr. Hett served as Berwyn Township Attorney, Berwyn City Attorney, 6<sup>th</sup> Ward Alderman, Mayor of the City of Berwyn from 1977-1980 and served as Judge of the Circuit Court of Cook County from 1980-2000. The North Berwyn Park District is honored to name our new park Thomas A. Hett Park.

Hett Park was made possible by a DCEO grant through the State of Illinois, the DCEO grant was sponsored by State Senator Martin A. Sandoval, 12<sup>th</sup> District. Hett Park is the newest park facility in the City of Berwyn. Hett Park, through a combination of features at Brocato playground, the Studio dance and fitness facility and our new water park will provide years of safe family friendly activities for the residents of North Berwyn.

#### the Studio

The Studio is a multipurpose facility that is specifically designed for dance and fitness; renovations include hardwood floors, mirrored walls and an enhanced sound system. The Studio will be used for a majority of the park district's dance and fitness programs, this facility will also be available for business functions, receptions and community use. Formerly Cuyler seasonal pool house, the Studio has been completely renovated into a facility that can be used year round.

#### **Water Park**

The North Berwyn Park District's second water park will begin construction in early 2014. This zero depth water park was designed with safety in mind, it will feature interactive water toys, green space, enhanced landscaping and a secure area for families to enjoy. This facility, when completed, will provide enjoyment in the summer months for all residents of the North Berwyn community. This facility replaces the former Cuyler pool. Tentative Completion Date - July 2014.



# You may qualify for ASSISTANCE from the Department of Human Services for Child Care!

- 1) Who is eligible for child care assistance from the state?
  - Low-income working families
  - TANF clients in education, training, or other work-related activities approved by their caseworkers
- Teen parents (under age 20) in elementary or high school, or a GED program
- Low income families who are in school or training and are not receiving TANF cash assistance. (Must work at least 10 hours per week if they are in a college degree program.) Occupational vocational training, GED, ABE, ESL, and other below postsecondary education programs do not have a work requirement for the first 24 months. High school does not have a work requirement.
- What does "low income" mean? Your family's countable income must be below the following guidelines

Family Size	Monthly Income Must Be Below
2	\$2,334
3	\$2,934
4	\$3,534
5	\$4,134
6	\$4,734
7	\$5,334
8	\$5,934

To determine your countable income, the gross wages paid by an employer are added to your other income (such as any government benefits, child support you receive, or self employment income.) Any child support you pay is subtracted from your income.

- 3) Must I be the child's parent to qualify for the program?
  No. A child's legal guardian or other relatives caring for the child are also eligible and should fill out an application form. Foster parents can receive child care assistance from the Department of Children and Family Services.
- 4) How old can the child be?
  All children <u>under</u> age 13 are eligible. Children 13 or older are eligible if they are under court supervision or have written documentation from a medical provider stating that they are physically or mentally incapable of caring for themselves.

#### **Room Rentals**

Reserve a room for your special event, rooms include tables, chairs, and clean-up. Arrive 30 minutes prior to rental time to add your own personal touch by decorating the room as you please. Room rentals are from 3:30-7:30 pm on Saturdays and 1:30-5:30 pm on Sundays.

Fee: \$125 Resident/\$150 Non-Resident Refundable Security Deposit: \$50

Extended room rental hours 5:30-7:30pm: \$50/hr. Sundays only

- 1. All Berwyn Residents Are Eligible to participate in the rental program.
- 2. All renters must fill out an application.
- 3. A valid driver's license or state I.D. is required to rent a facility or equipment.
- 4. All rental deposits may be paid with a check or cash. Checks must have preprinted address that matches address of the driver's license or state I.D. No starter checks may be used for the deposit.
- 5. All rental fees and deposits must be paid at the time rental application is processed. No dates will be reserved until the application is processed.
- 6. All renters must be 18 years of age.
- 7. Rental applications must be processed at least ten days in advance for facility rentals, and five days in advance for equipment rentals.
- 8. All rented facilities or equipment must be in reasonable condition after use, determination of the condition of the facility or equipment will be determined by the North Berwyn Park District. All renters agree to these terms by completing the application form for consideration of renting a facility or equipment from the North Berwyn Park District. Potential renters that do not agree to these terms should not submit a rental application.
- The North Berwyn Park District reserves the right to deny any request for rental of a facility or equipment for reasons that may remain confidential. All park programs take precedence over any other event.
- 10. Rentals may be denied or cancelled at the discretion of the Executive Director without reason or explanation.
- 11. Any rules not specifically mentioned may be instituted at any time for the good of the North Berwyn Park District.
