

PARENTS RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Within six months of initial child care assistance eligibility, an eligible family with an absent parent must have an active collection case with the Division of Child Support Services at the Department of Healthcare and Family Services. A case must be opened against the absent parent of every child within the family's household.

If a family does not comply with this requirement within the given time frame, the child care case will be canceled.




