


Leadership by Design

Rising high school 9–12th graders are invited to collaborate with the Winston-Salem community and local professionals in designing for social change through two week-long summer camps.

This design-thinking summer camp experience for high school students explores firsthand how design-based solutions can address real world problems. During these one-week day camps, students will use the design process to engage with local organizations in proposing solutions to a systemic challenge.

Taught by local design professionals and located with access to site tours and state-of-the-art classrooms, each camp will introduce students to multiple design professions, develop leadership skills, and empower students to make a positive impact on Winston-Salem’s community.
