Debit & Credit Card Security Tips

- Sign the back of the card as soon as you get it.
- Never give your account number to someone calling you or sending you an e-mail.
- Never give your PIN to anyone. That includes family members and friends.
- Never leave your credit card and/or debit card as a "security deposit" or as identification.
- When you are expecting a new or replacement card, look for it in the mail. If you do not receive it in a timely manner, notify the issuer immediately.
- Never leave receipts behind where someone could pick them up.
 Destroy them as if you would any other document with personal or financial information.
- Always review financial and account statements to ensure accuracy.
- Report suspected fraud immediately to your financial institution. The sooner you report suspected fraud, the more likely the losses can be minimized.
- If you are planning to visit a foreign country or are using your debit card to make a purchase from a company in a foreign country, please notify us in advance, this could eliminate any delay in the use of your card.
