Grant Report	<p>Idaho Heritage Trust 100,000 grant has been approved for restoration of the Auditorium. Consultation with Katherine Kirk and Shannon Sardel will be necessary to complete the details on what qualifies as renovation vs. restoration. There are major issues:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Envelope and all water must be fixed first.2) On the interior plaster, We need to have SCOPE of work with details for all work needed by architect or independent contractor that we pay for3) 3 bids will need to be widely publicized for the work based on the SCOPE information. <p>We are working with the Consortium of Bonner County, Bonner General Health and the Panida in a partnership under the EPA Grant Opportunity Offering. This will involve new HVAC and ducting for Main and Little Theaters.</p> <p>The grant application period begins in March, so we would like to complete our application by the end of February to ensure we have a good shot at the funds, which are first come, first served.
