Craft - Baking Soda Volcano

A volcano is a mountain that opens downward to a pool of molten rock below the surface of the earth. When pressure builds up, eruptions occur. Gases and rock shoot up through the opening and spill over or fill the air with lava fragments.

Eruptions can cause lateral blasts, lava flows, hot ash flows, mudslides, avalanches, falling ash and floods. Volcano eruptions have been known to knock down entire forests. An erupting volcano can trigger tsunamis, flash floods, earthquakes, mudflows and rockfall!

Materials:

- soda bottle
- 6 cups of flour
- 2 cups of salt
- 4 tablespoons cooking oil
- 2 tablespoons of baking soda
- dish washing detergent
- food color
- vinegar
- warm water
- baking dish or pan





Directions:

- 1. First, make the cone of the baking soda volcano.

 Mix 6 cups flour, 2 cups salt, 4 tablespoons cooking oil and 2 cups warm water. The mixture should be smooth and firm. Add more warm water if needed.
- 2. Stand the soda bottle in the baking pan and mold the dough around it into a volcano shape. *Don't cover the opening or drop dough in it.
- 3. Fill the bottle most of the way full with warm water and a bit of red food color.
- 4. Add 6 drops of detergent to the bottle contents.
- 5. Add 2 tablespoons of baking soda to the contents.
- 6. Slowly pour vinegar into the bottle.
- 7. Watch the eruption!
