## Applicability

These General Terms and Conditions (“**Terms**”) apply to any individual applying to the Program (an “**Applicant**”). The Applicant must accept these Terms in full before applying to the Program. If admitted to the Program, Applicant will be provided with additional contractual terms. These Terms shall be combined with and form an integral part of those additional terms.

## The Concept

AW Academy provides intensive remote accelerated learning courses for individuals wishing to obtain proficiency in a new subject matter. The Program is a digital, web-based program. Upon completion of the Program, the Applicant can expect to have a sufficient skillset to start a career as a web developer. The Program will provide the Applicant with knowledge and practical experience within the following topics:

- Programming Fundamentals & Problem-solving
- Responsive Web design using HTML, CSS and Frameworks
- UX and UI Design
- JavaScript Programming
- Version Control
- HTTP & REST API
- React
- Redux
- Component Libraries
- React Native
- Vue.js Basics
- TypeScript
- Angular Basics

- Data Visualization

### **Application Steps**

Application to the Program will be made on AW Academy's website. When applying to the Program, the Applicant will be asked to provide, among other things, a personal description, information about previous work experience, reasons for applying, and contact information.

The Applicant will be asked to perform online admission tests to determine whether the Applicant meets the standards of the requirements profile necessary in order to commence participation in the Program. The tests will measure the Applicants general cognitive abilities.

The tests and application are then followed by two online interviews. During the first online interview held by our recruitment partner Academic Work, the Applicant will be asked certain foundational questions regarding prerequisite practical matters: such as the ability to finance the Program, availability, access to a computer and functioning networks, as well as questions intended to ensure the Applicant meets the eligibility requirements. During the second interview, the Applicant will be asked questions regarding their motivations, ambitions for the training, as well as competency-based questions considering their personality traits, perseverance, and teamwork.

If the Applicant fulfills the requirements and prerequisites, the Applicant will be presented to AW Academy. AW Academy will conduct one final online interview with complementary questions regarding background designed to get better acquainted with the Applicant. The last step in the application phase is the digital signing of the contract accompanied by an invoice sent via email.

All application steps are necessary for AW Academy's determination as to the Applicant's suitability to participate in the Program.

### **Eligibility requirements**

The Program does not require any previous programming skills. However, the Applicant should have a genuine interest and basic understanding of programming and computer skills. In addition, the Applicant must meet the following requirements:

- Applicant must be 18 years of age
- Applicant must be fluent in English, written and spoken
- Applicant must undergo and successfully complete the admission tests
- Applicant must undergo and be approved in the telephone interviews
- Applicant may need to undergo and be approved in a credit check

### **Acceptance**

If the Applicant fulfills all eligibility requirements, the Applicant may be admitted to the Program. The decision to accept the Applicant is made by AW Academy in its sole discretion.

If the Applicant does not meet AW Academy's eligibility requirements, or if AW Academy reasonably determines that the Applicant is not suitable to participate in the Program, AW Academy reserves the right to deny Applicant's participation in the Program.

AW Academy may also deny the Applicant's application if the total number of accepted Applicants does not fill an entire Program class.

Once the Applicant has been admitted to the Program, certificate of admission will be sent to the email address provided by the Applicant in the application.

### **Right of withdrawal**

Once admitted to the Program and having signed the additional contractual terms, Applicant has the right to withdraw from his or her contractual obligation within 14 days without giving any reason. To exercise the right of withdrawal, Applicant must inform AW Academy by an unequivocal statement (e.g. a letter sent by post or email). Applicant may use a model withdrawal form, as provided by the local consumer agency, but this is not obligatory.

### **Personal data**

AW Academy will process personal data related to the Applicant. Information about how AW Academy processes personal data and for what purposes can be found in AW Academy's [Privacy Policy](#).

### **Force majeure**

AW Academy shall not be liable for failure or delay in performance in the application process resulting from causes beyond AW Academy's reasonable control and that could not reasonably have been foreseen or provided against (aka force majeure).

### **Governing law and disputes**

These Terms shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the substantive laws of Sweden. The choice of law may not, however, have the result of depriving the Applicant of the protection afforded to the Applicant by provisions that cannot be derogated from by agreement by virtue of local applicable law.

Any dispute, controversy, or claim arising from or in connection with these Terms shall be settled in the appropriate court having jurisdiction over the Applicant by virtue of the Applicant's residence or domicile.

### **Changes**

AW Academy has the right at any time to amend, supplement, or terminate these Terms without notice and with immediate effect from the time AW Academy posts any such updated terms on its website in the same location as these Terms.
