OUTCOMES- KALEIDOSCOPE COMMUNITY SERVICES AND THE 2ND STREET COMMONS

- 250 guests visit the 2nd Street Commons each week- that's 12,000 guests in the last year.
- 2nd Chance Discipleship Ministry volunteers run Bible Studies, serve breakfast meals, and provide sack lunches six mornings each week (1000 meals each month). This ministry is a partnership of five different churches and over 20 volunteers.
- Eight different ministries use the 2nd Street Commons each week for recovery groups, Bible study, home groups, and church services.
- Heritage Health provides a paid Peer Support Specialist to be at the 2nd Street Commons 29 hours per week.
- Heritage Health Mobile Medical Clinic comes to the 2nd Street Commons one day per week; HH medical staff visits the 2nd Street Commons an additional 3 mornings each week.
- Since January of 2016, Kaleidoscope Community Services has housed 16 people, (including three children), in our two RV's and tiny house.
- In the last year, Kaleidoscope Community Services has helped over 20 people find employment and over 20 people find housing.
- In the last year, Kaleidoscope Community Services has distributed over \$ 20,000.00 directly to those in need. These benevolence funds have paid for emergency hotel rooms, prescriptions, bus tickets, car repairs, tires, dental work, and more.
- Kaleidoscope Community Services has re-distributed literally tons of surplus food, clothing, and donations to other local nonprofits.
- Since its start in August of 2013, Kaleidoscope Community Services has had the help of over 300 volunteers from over 30 different churches.
- Dozens upon dozens of volunteers and guest have drawn closer to Christ through the ministry of Kaleidoscope Community Services and the 2nd Street Commons.
