



## Tuition and Fees Information

Tuition is designed to cover the actual cost of educating students. Tuition encompasses the cost of academic instruction, books and materials, facility, and other operational expenses. We are committed to keeping tuition costs as low as possible while ensuring financial stability for the school and church.

### 2021 - 2022 Academic Year Tuition:

Due at the time of (re-)enrollment is a non-refundable down payment equal to 10% of the oldest child's tuition. The following options are available to pay the remaining tuition balance. Pay-in-full on or before June 30th (for a 5% reduction) or pay in equal installments over ten or twelve months. All three option amounts listed below reflect the amount due following the 10% non-refundable down payment. Monthly installment payments are due no later than the 5th of each month. Late fees are ascribed on the 6th of each month in the amount of \$25. In addition, multi-student discounts are available and are not reflected below.

- \$3,050 three full-days of Kindergarten: Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday.
  - 10% non-refundable down payment \$305.00.
  - Payment in full of \$2,607.75
  - **ten** monthly payments of \$274.50. September 1 through June 1
  - **twelve** monthly payments of \$228.75. July 1 through June 1
- \$5,083 five full-days of Grades 1 – 6:
  - 10% non-refundable down payment \$508.30.
  - Payment in full of \$4,345.97
  - **ten** monthly payments of \$457.47. September 1 through June 1
  - **twelve** monthly payments of \$381.23. July 1 through June 1
- \$6,218 five full-days of Grades 7 - 12
  - 10% non-refundable down payment \$621.80.
  - Payment in full of \$5,316.40
  - **ten** monthly payments of \$559.62. September 1 through June 1
  - **twelve** monthly payments of \$466.35. July 1 through June 1

Family Tuition Rates:	
1 <sup>st</sup> Student	Full price (highest tuition)
2 <sup>nd</sup> Student	25% remission
3 <sup>rd</sup> Student	30% remission
4 <sup>th</sup> Student	40% remission
5 <sup>th</sup> plus	90% off the 5 <sup>th</sup> and more students

Please NOTE: If a family is delinquent at the time of withdrawal, the Academy will not release transcripts.

### Cancellation Policy:

Upon signing the tuition form, you are agreeing with Calvary Classical Academy to fulfill your financial obligation. If you withdraw your students from the upcoming year for any reason, tuition will be due as follows:

Between **May 1 through June 1**, two month's tuition is due, along with the non-refundable down payment.

Between **June 1 through July 31**, the first semester's tuition is due.

After **August 1**, all remaining tuition is due.

### **Re-enrollment Dates:**

Calvary Classical Academy staggers acceptance of applications for fall enrollments. See chart below:

- Enrollment deadline for returning students and their siblings:
  - February 26
- Open enrollment for new students
  - March 1 – April 30
- Late enrollment for either returning or new enrollments (Late enrollments are charged a \$25 fee for expedited processing and placement.)
  - May 1 – August 1
