

BEVERSTON PARISH COUNCIL
Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held at Beverston Village Hall on
24th September 2019

- 1 Apologies:** Jorn Rixen-Osterbro
- 2 Minutes:** The minutes of the meeting held on Monday 8th April 2019 were approved
- 3 Matters arising not on the agenda:** No matters arising
- 4 Valley Trading Planning Application:** It was noted that to date there are 158 objections to the application and that the Statutory Expiry Date of 29th September for the application is likely to be extended. The requested further information from Valley Trading re lorry movements has still not been received by GCC.
- 5 Other Planning Applications:** It was noted that the planning application submitted by 12 Beverston to make a parking area beside the property by repositioning the stone wall along the lane has been refused.
- 6 Village Hall:** Councillor McMeekin has written to accept the offer for the Village Hall to be passed to the Village. He asked for confirmation that the offer includes the garden and parking area. It was noted that a trust would be set up to manage the Village Hall and the Parish Council would be the sole trustee. To what extent the Parish Council would be able to contribute towards the initial conveyancing costs was briefly discussed.
- 7 Financial:** The bank balance stands at £19,070. It was agreed that Caroline and Oliver should be able to access the online bank account. Fiona agreed to set this in motion.
- 8 Any other business:**
 - a. Road Closure:** It was noted that the road would be closed for resurfacing between Tetbury and Beverston. Details of the closure had been emailed to Beverston residents and everyone had also received a notification letter.
 - b. Beverston Castle:** It was noted that the Castle is now being marketed separate to the land for £1.9 million.
