

**BEVERSTON PARISH COUNCIL**  
**Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held via Zoom on 13<sup>th</sup> April 2021**

**1 Apologies:** None

**2 Minutes:** The minutes of the meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> January 2021 were approved and the Clerk will visit the Chairman to get them signed.

**3 Matters arising not on the agenda:** Caroline Lowsley Williams wanted it recorded that there would be a £5,000 donation coming from her family for the Village Hall.

**4. Planning:**

**(i) The Grain Store.** The Chairman invited Parish Councillors to give their views on the grain store planning application. As a result of this discussion a motion that the Parish Council should object to the application was proposed by David Morris and seconded by Dermot McMeekin and received unanimous support. A draft objection letter would now be drafted and circulated to Parish Councillors for comments.

**(ii) Woodlodge.** The Councillors discussed the Woodlodge expansion application and it was agreed that Oliver Preston would draft a letter in response to the application. He would show it to David Morris and Jorn Rixen-Osterbro before submitting it to Cotswold District Council.

Other actions points that arose from the discussion included: David Morris contacting Woodlodge about the windmill that hasn't worked for years and the Clerk will circulate details of the application to the Parish.

**5. The new anti-hare coursing banks:** The Parish Council were reminded that contact had been made with the Environment Agency regarding the poor soil used for the banks. No reply has been received so the clerk will chase them up.

**6. Beverston Village Hall.** Dermot McMeekin said that a registered charity number is needed for the Village Hall. The Clerk reported that she is still trying to open up a bank account for the Village Hall Trust.

**7. Any other business:**

It was noted that the bench outside the village hall needs to be replaced. Not a priority but maybe a new bench could be in memory of Jane Rook.
