



# Laundry recommendations

for Reflex Microfibre- and Ultra microfibre textiles

- > The washing machine must be intended for washing cleaning materials.
- > Sort the laundry; microfibre mopcloths and cloths are washed separately.
- > Use a detergent suitable for microfibre textiles. Dose by using dosing equipment.
- > Always follow Rekola's instructions for temperature, washing program and tumble drying.
- > For clean, functional, and durable materials, service your machines regularly.

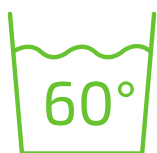

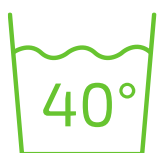

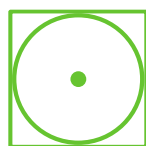
