USAGE DIRECTIONS

CetaiN® can be applied to all field and row crops, fruit and nut trees, vegetables, berries, grapes and turf. CetaiN may be applied directly to the soil or through irrigation systems. Mixing with irrigation water for field storage is generally not recommended. Products blended should be used immediately and not stored for prolonged periods.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

CetaiN should be added to tank water with sufficient agitation. It may be combined with most fertilizer solutions using adequate agitation during mixing. A jar compatibility test is recommended before mixing with other products.

APPLICATION

CetaiN may be applied pre-plant, as a side-dress, through fertigation systems, top-dressed or banded to the soil.

UAN-28/32 or CAN-17:

Mix 1 ounce of CetaiN per 1-2 gallons of liquid fertilizer to stabilize and enhance liquid nitrogen.

GENERAL INFORMATION

CetaiN is a low pH, highly oxygenated carbon-based liquid that stabilizes nutrients and enhances nutrient availability.
