- I will help the Pledge reach 6,000 signatories by talking about the Pledge and encouraging others to sign.
- I will appoint women as arbitrators on an equal opportunity basis.
- I will ensure lists of arbitrator candidates I am involved in putting together include a fair representation of women.
- I will refer to the <u>Checklist of</u>
 Best Practice for the <u>Selection</u>
 of <u>Arbitrators</u> when constituting
 a tribunal
- I will consider using the Pledge's Arbitrator Search Tool hosted by ICCA to identify more female candidates and will recommend the service to other members of my team.
- I will go the extra mile to diligence strong female candidates for every list of arbitrators with a view to recommending their appointments.
- I will ensure my firm/arbitral institution has a policy in place for tracking the number of female arbitrators we appoint.
- I will call out any arbitration conferences, events and/or publications that do not have sufficient female representation.
- I will act as a mentor to a junior female colleague within the arbitration community.
- I will bring a male colleague with me to the next event on women in arbitration/the Pledge.
