

1 Terms of website use

1.1 This page (together with the documents referred to on it) tells you the terms of use on which you may make use of our website www.kammandsons.com, whether as a guest or a registered user. Please read these terms of use carefully before you start to use the site. By using our site, you indicate that you accept these terms of use and that you agree to abide by them. If you do not agree to these terms of use, please refrain from using our site.

2 Information about us

2.1 www.haycocks.london (“our site”) is operated by The Haycock’s Drinks Company Ltd (“We”).

We are registered in England and Wales under company number 09177941 and have our registered office at 1 Kings Avenue, London, United Kingdom, N21 3NA.

2.2 We are a limited company.

3 Accessing our site

3.1 Access to our site is permitted on a temporary basis, and we reserve the right to withdraw or amend any service we provide on our site without notice (see below). We will not be liable if for any reason our site is unavailable at any time or for any period.

3.2 From time to time, we may restrict access to some parts of our site, or our entire site, to a limited class of users.

3.3 You are responsible for making all arrangements necessary for you to have access to our site. You are also responsible for ensuring that all persons who access our site through your internet connection are aware of these terms, and that they comply with them.

4 Acceptable use

4.1 When using our site, you must comply with the provisions of our acceptable use policy, which are as follows:

4.1.1 you may use our site only for lawful purposes. You may not use our site:

- (a) in any way that breaches any applicable local, national or international law or regulation;
- (b) in any way that is unlawful or fraudulent, or has any unlawful or fraudulent purpose or effect;
- (c) to transmit, or procure the sending of, any unsolicited or unauthorised advertising or promotional material or any other form of similar solicitation (spam); or

- (d) to knowingly transmit any data, send or upload any material that contains viruses, Trojan horses, worms, time-bombs, keystroke loggers, spyware, adware or any other harmful programs or similar computer code designed to adversely affect the operation of any computer software or hardware.

4.1.2 You also agree:

- (a) not to reproduce, duplicate, copy or re-sell any part of our site in contravention of the provisions of these terms of website use; and
- (b) not to access without authority, interfere with, damage or disrupt:
 - (i) any part of our site;
 - (ii) any equipment or network on which our site is stored;
 - (iii) any software used in the provision of our site; or
 - (iv) any equipment or network or software owned or used by any third party.

4.1.3 Suspension and termination

- (a) We will determine, in our discretion, whether there has been a breach of our acceptable use policy through your use of our site. When a breach of this policy has occurred, we may take such action as we deem appropriate.
- (b) Failure to comply with our acceptable use policy constitutes a material breach of the terms of use upon which you are permitted to use our site, and may result in our taking all or any of the following actions:
 - (i) immediate, temporary or permanent withdrawal of your right to use our site;
 - (ii) issue of a warning to you;
 - (iii) legal proceedings against you for reimbursement of all costs on an indemnity basis (including, but not limited to, reasonable administrative and legal costs) resulting from the breach;
 - (iv) further legal action against you; and/or
 - (v) disclosure of such information to law enforcement authorities as we reasonably feel is necessary.
- (c) We exclude liability for actions taken in response to breaches of this acceptable use policy. The responses described in this policy are not limited, and we may take any other action we reasonably deem appropriate.

5 Intellectual property rights

- 5.1 We are the owner or the licensee of all intellectual property rights in our site, and in the material published on it. Those works are protected by copyright laws and treaties around the world. All such rights are reserved.
- 5.2 You may print off one copy, and may download extracts, of any page(s) from our site for your personal reference and you may draw the attention of others within your organisation to material posted on our site.

8 Our liability

 - 8.1.1 all conditions, warranties and other terms which might otherwise be implied by statute, common law or the law of equity;
 - 8.1.2 any liability for any direct, indirect or consequential loss or damage incurred by any user in connection with our site or in connection with the use,

inability to use, or results of the use of our site, any websites linked to it and any materials posted on it, including:

- (a) loss of income or revenue;
- (b) loss of business;
- (c) loss of profits or contracts;
- (d) loss of anticipated savings;
- (e) loss of data;
- (f) loss of goodwill; and
- (g) wasted management or office time;

whether caused by tort (including negligence), breach of contract or otherwise, even if foreseeable, provided that this condition shall not prevent claims for loss of or damage to your tangible property or any other claims for direct financial loss that are not excluded by any of the categories set out above.

- 8.1.3 This does not affect our liability for death or personal injury arising from our negligence, nor our liability for fraudulent misrepresentation or misrepresentation as to a fundamental matter, nor any other liability which cannot be excluded or limited under applicable law.

9 Viruses, hacking and other offences

- 9.1 You must not misuse our site by knowingly introducing viruses, Trojan horses, worms, logic bombs or other material which is malicious or technologically harmful. You must not attempt to gain unauthorised access to our site, the server on which our site is stored or any server, computer or database connected to our site. You must not attack our site via a denial-of-service attack or a distributed denial-of service attack.
- 9.2 By breaching this provision, you would commit a criminal offence under the Computer Misuse Act 1990. We will report any such breach to the relevant law enforcement authorities and we will co-operate with those authorities by disclosing your identity to them.
