Dog Park Permits

For the safety of park users and their dogs, an annual permit is needed for those wishing to use the park. Dog park permits can be purchased in person at The Bird Park Administration Offices, 893 W. Station St. Kankakee, or by mailing this application form with payment to Kankakee Valley Park District. Applicants may register up to three dogs. Permits are valid from the date of issue until December 31 of that calendar year.

Dog Park Usage

Once a dog park permit is purchased, visitors can use the dog park year-round during park hours. The dog park may periodically be closed for restoration, mowing, maintenance, or due to weather conditions.

Dog Park Rules

- All users are required to purchase a dog park permit prior to entry, and to wear the ID lanyard.
- Owners may only have three dogs in the park at one time.
- Dogs must be leashed when entering and exiting the dog park.
- Please use caution when visiting the dog park and leash and/or remove your dog from the park at the first sign of aggressive behavior.
- Owners must remain with their dogs inside the fenced dog park and keep their dog under control at all times. Dogs must not be allowed to disturb, harass, or interfere with wildlife or visitors.
- Owners are legally responsible for their dogs and any injuries or damage caused by their dogs.
- Children 15 years and under must be accompanied by an adult and not left unattended at the dog park.
- Dogs must display a current rabies tag.
- Owners must leave unhealthy dogs and those in heat at home.
- Caution and good judgment should be used when introducing puppies to the dog park. Puppies under six months of age are not allowed.
- Owners must clean up after their dogs by requirement of Ordinance 1.1
- Small dog treats for training purposes are permitted; please refrain from bringing other food or treat items into the dog park.
- No alcohol is allowed in the dog parks.
- Failure to comply with any of the above rules may result in fines and/or revocation of your dog park permit.
- All state, county, local and Park District ordinances will be enforced.

Leptospirosis Alert

Leptospirosis is a bacterial disease that can be transmitted from animals to humans. It has been recommended that dogs that frequent parks and wooded areas receive a Leptospirosis vaccine. The Park District has not made any changes to its policy at this time that requires this vaccination to obtain a dog park permit. Please consult your pet's veterinarian for more information.
