On all occasions when the use of the hall is permitted after 23:00 hours, all music shall cease at least 30 minutes before the permitted closing time.

## **Annex 1 - Mandatory Conditions**

- Every supply of alcohol under the Premises Licence must be made or authorised by the Management Committee.
- (1) The Responsible Person must ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
  - (2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises
    - (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to
      - (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the Responsible Person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
      - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
    - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
    - (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a icensing objective;
    - (d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner;
    - (e) dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of disability).
- The Responsible Person must ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
- The Responsible Person must ensure that:
  - (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for

consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures:

- (i) beer or cider: 1/2 pint;
- (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
- (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml.
- (b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and
- (c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available.
- The Relevant Person (Responsible Person) shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.
- (1) The Premises Licence holder or Club Premises Certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
  - (2) The Designated Premises Supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.
  - (3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the Responsible Person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either:
    - (a) a holographic mark, or
    - (b) an ultraviolet feature.

Note:

In section 153(4) of the Licensing Act 2003, "Responsible Person" means:

- (a) In relation to licensed premises:
  - (i) the holder of a Premises Licence in respect of the premises;
  - (ii) the Designated Premises Supervisor (if any) under such a licence; or,

- (iii) any individual aged 18 or over who is authorised for the purposes of this section by such a holder or supervisor.
- (b) In relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a Club Premises Certificate, any Member or Officer of the Club present on the premises in a capacity which enables him to prevent the supply in question.

## Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

#### General

- The sale or supply of alcohol, other than any sale or supply under Temporary Event Notices, shall be restricted to those persons attending pre-booked functions, or any other such activities, which have the express prior permission of the Committee.
- The sale or supply of alcohol, other than those made in accordance with a
  Temporary Event Notice, shall only be permitted under the control of persons
  who have been nominated by, and have received appropriate training from, the
  Committee for those purposes.
- The nominated person shall have control of the premises and shall ensure that all conditions of the licence are complied with.

#### Prevention of Crime and Disorder

 Persons who are drunk and / or disorderly, or showing signs of aggression shall not be admitted to the premises

#### Prevention of Public Nuisance

 Measures shall be taken to ensure that patrons leave the premises in a quiet and orderly manner.

#### Protection of Children from Harm


- Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied to any persons under 18 years of age.
- Proof of age shall be required from any person who appears to be under 18 years of age.
