Intermediate Class

- **Fusing 101** - Required for Independent Artist Studio time, and attendance in Advanced Classes. Come to Silo Glass to learn fundamental basics of fusing glass in this three-session class. You will learn about cutting, preparing for the kiln, firing process and several techniques to get you going with Fused Glass. Join us for this fun and informative class! This three-sessions, 4-hours each, provides a more in-depth knowledge of glass fusing. Maximum 4 people per class. Three sessions, 4 hours per session, \$300 pp.*

Advanced Classes

(Minimum Level Required – “Fusing 101” or equivalent)

- **Glass Salvage** – A two-part advanced course taught by Tutor Laurie Rich that is designed to support artists exploring the art of glass movement and flow, and especially turning those pesky glass scraps, transforming them into something uniquely stunning and beautiful! Especially useful to all advanced artists and those with home studios, this is a must! Maximum of 8 students. \$180 pp for both classes if you use Silo supplied glass and \$140 pp for both classes if you bring your own scrap glass.^

- **Advanced Snowflakes** – Join us for this class making snowflakes for ornaments or dishes. Complete your project in studio time after they have fired. Maximum 8 students. \$60pp.

- **Vitrigraph Pulls** – (Free Tutorial/Workshop) **MAX 4 persons.** Please reserve your spot and/or call to express your interest. This is a “HOT” glass pull. If you have reserved your spot, please be mindful of following safety requirements:

 - **LONG SLEEVES (tight fitting at wrists).**

 - **CLOSED SHOES OR BOOTS – preferably leather (no holes); tennis-shoes or trainers.**

- **Strip Construction** – Two sessions taught by visiting Tutor, Laurie Rich. Class combines opaque and transparent glass in strips, turned on edge, glued and dammed to produce beautiful artworks. Second session is coldworking and finishing of the pieces made in the first session. Max 6 students. \$250pp for both sessions. Pay ½ to hold your space.^
