We have an outstanding reputation for providing quality and innovative education for students from Pre-Kindergarten to Year 12.

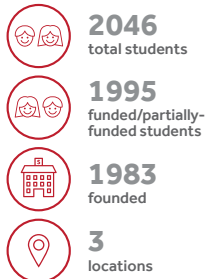

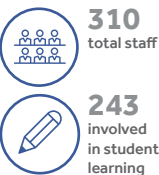
In 2020, St Stephen's School continued to perform strongly across both academic and non-academic areas.

- A total of 33 students placed inside the State's top 10% for WACE and 14 of these students were placed inside the State's top 5% for WACE.
- 91.7% of students who applied, were offered a place at university. (state average - 89.5%)
- 99.48% of students achieved a WACE (state average - 91.49%).
- 193 full time eligible Year 12 VET students were awarded 227 AQF certificates.
- 47 students received 50 Certificates of Merit and Distinction.

WORKFORCE COMPOSITION

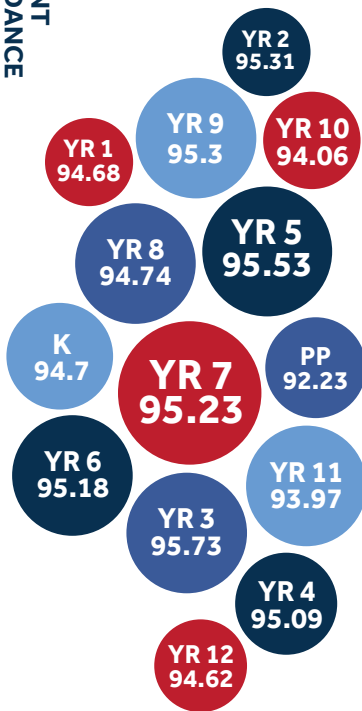

PROCEDURE FOR DAILY ABSENTEES

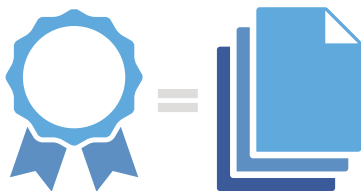
Electronic system of notifying, identifying and reporting absences involving email, phone and text message.

SURVEY EXTRACTS 2020

The unpredictable year the world experienced in 2020 created many changes to our lives. Given this situation the St Stephen's School 2018-2020 Strategic Plan Staying True & Moving Forward was extended to 2021 in order to allow the School community the time to work together through open consultations and feedback to assist in framing the plans for our next Strategic Plan.

The three underpinning intents of the 2018-2020 plan are: Our Purpose, Our People and Our Place. While the current plan reflects a focus on consolidation in a number of areas across the School, opportunities for growth have also been achieved as evidenced by the results of the MMG Education surveys and the measures of success within the Strategic Plan 2018-2020.

In 2020, 668 parents, 1157 students and 178 staff from the Duncraig and Carramar campuses participated in the surveys. They provided views on areas including academic performance, pastoral care, biblical studies, extracurricular, sport, communications, reputation and facilities.
