

SITE SURVEY & INSTALLATION REQUIREMENTS BATHROOM PANELLING

Please read through the site survey requirements thoroughly and confirm by email when your site is ready for the final measurements to be taken

- The latest drawings including elevations and plan view have been sent to Saligo Design
- OLD TILES REMOVED where necessary and walls prepared to a smooth and finished standard
- ALL TAPS, SPOUTS, COVER PLATES AND WASTE installed in final position then removed
- Bath to be fixed into final position
- ANY OTHER FITTINGS that are required to penetrate the glass to be installed then removed
- All SOCKETS fitted in final position including FACE PLATES (minimum 50mm for the edge of the glass and 15mm between sockets)
- 10mm PLYWOOD fitted behind wall hung WC'S, bidets and basins. This should be made 10mm smaller all around to allow our glass to slightly tuck behind the sanitary ware to give the appearance that it goes right behind them
- Glass bath panel to be on Ply Former
- Arrangement has been made to remove any TEMPORARY WORKTOPS
- ALL BASE CABINETS, WORKTOP SUPPORTS and END PANEL installed
- THE AREA HAS BEEN COMPLETELY CLEARED as the site surveyor cannot be responsible for breakage or damage if they move any items
- The customer or an authorised representative will be on site to allow access into the property and to instruct the site surveyor on design specification (If an authorised representative is not on site, the survey will be ABORTED)

Please Note: Once the site survey has been completed it will not be possible to add to or alter fixtures, fittings or walls in any way

Parking for Site Survey & Installation

- Confirm parking options
- If free parking is not available, a parking permit will be arranged for the date of the site survey for the Site Surveyor
- If free parking is not available and a parking permit cannot be supplied for the date of the site survey, please note this could affect the Site Surveyor's punctuality

By confirming the area is ready for a Site Survey, you accept that a £200 fee plus VAT is payable for any survey or installation that is cancelled within 48 hours of the agreed time or if the site fails to meet the requirements detailed above. Incomplete surveys or installations will also incur additional direct costs, such as fuel, parking etc.
