Objective

How it works

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Gather a diverse student focus group that will lead the design of the community center programs.
- 2. Through the focus group, ask what causes your students care about most. Identify charities and local organizations in line with these causes.
- 3. As a suggested first event, host a fundraiser for one of these local charities and non-profit organizations.
- 4. Throughout, help students identify funding partners to help offset any costs in hosting school events.
- 5. Celebrate students taking ownership of their school, by sharing their stories across the school and social media!
