OFF-PEAK SERVICE RIDER RATE SCHEDULE

(Name of Schedule)

AVAILABLE: In the retail distribution service territory of the District.

APPLICABLE: To Customers who are served under the following rate schedules:

General Service Demand (Rate Codes 23, 25, 54 & 66)
High Tension Service (Rate Codes 91 & 93)

BASE RATE: The base rates, charges and Base Rate Adjustments for electric service regularly applicable under the rate schedules listed above.

For loads of 500 kW or more (or at the option of the Customer for loads of less than 500 kW), and upon application to the District and approval by the District, the Customer's demands will be adjusted for billing purposes during off-peak periods subject to the following provisions:

1. The provision entitled "Determination of Billing Demand" in each of the above rate schedules specifies the demand to be used for billing purposes. For off-peak power service, the demand shall be the highest measured integrated kilowatt load during any thirty (30) minute period occurring between the following on-peak hours:

For any day within the monthly billing periods of October through May: 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. ("Central Time").

For any day within the monthly billing periods of June through September: 10:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. ("Central Time").

Such on-peak hours shall not include Sundays and the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

The District reserves the right to revise these on-peak hours as required to reflect changes experienced in the District's system load pattern or operations.

TAX CLAUSE: In the event of the imposition of any new or increased tax or any payment in lieu thereof, in excess of that provided for under Article VIII, Section 11 of the Nebraska Constitution, by any lawful authority on the production, transmission, or sale of electricity, the rate provided herein may be increased to reflect the amount of such tax or in lieu of tax increase.

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2. Where power factor adjustments are applicable, such adjustments shall be made to the on-peak and off-peak demands established according to the hours as set forth in paragraph 1 above.
3. The applicable Billing Demand for each month cannot be less than fifty percent (50%) of the highest demand, power factor adjusted if applicable, recorded during off-peak hours.
4. Customers with loads less than 500 kW taking service under this rate schedule shall be required to make the necessary investment in any new facilities or special metering required to implement this rate schedule.
5. The District, at its option, may install either a recording demand meter or a standard time of use meter to implement this rate schedule.
6. The District retains and reserves the right, power, and authority to modify, revise, amend, replace, repeal or cancel this rate schedule, at any time and in whole or in part, by resolution adopted by the District's Board of Directors.

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
