Postoperative Instructions for Excision of a Skin Lesion

1. Clean the incision and sutures with peroxide as needed. Apply over the counter Bacitracin antibiotic ointment three times a day.
2. You may shower. Apply the ointment to the incision before showering and dry the incision after showering.
3. Call if the incision becomes increasingly red, painful, swollen, or has yellow drainage.
4. Use Advil, Motrin, or Tylenol for pain.
5. Sutures are removed 5 to 14 days after the procedure.
6. The intention is for the procedure to result in an acceptable scar. Patient healing is variable. If scar results are bothersome, additional scar revision may be needed.
