

## **BATTING CAGE RULES**

The following rules have been established by the Town of Somers Parks & Recreation Board to ensure the safe and efficient use of the batting cage. Individuals and/or groups observed to be in violation of said rules are subject to loss of privilege as deemed appropriate by the Superintendent of Parks and Recreation

All users of the batting cage understand that they do so at their own risk

After all sanctioned organizations have been accommodated; the cage will be open to individuals on a first-come, first-served basis

- In the event that an individual is using the cage they must yield to any Town sponsored team
- The cage may be used for hitting pitched balls, batting tee drills, soft toss drills and pitching warm-up
- Soft toss by more than one player at a time and into the side fencing is prohibited
- The batter must wear an approved helmet at all times
- Only one batter and one adult pitcher are allowed in the cage at a time
- Pitcher must throw from/stand behind the L screen
- No unsupervised practice swinging is permitted immediately outside the cage area
- Spectators must remain outside the designated cage area
- Participants are responsible for keeping the cage clean
- Any damage to the cage should be reported to the Recreation Office
