REACH Compliance Statement

Re: EU Regulation 1907/2006/EG

To Our Valued Customers:

According to the EU Regulation (REACH: Registration, Evaluation, and Authorization of Chemicals) that became effective on June 1, 2007, substances of which more than one ton were produced in the EU, or imported into the EU respectively, must be registered with the European Chemicals Agency.

The coatings produced by United Protective Technologies, LLC (UPT) are classified in terms of REACH as articles.

A substance that is contained in an article must only be registered if the following criteria are met cumulatively: the substance is present in the article in quantities totaling over 1 ton per producer or importer per year and the substance is intended to be released under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use. The substances present in our coatings do not have to be registered, as we do not meet the conditions required for mandatory registration.

The coatings produced by UPT do not contain any SVHC (Substances of Very High Concern) listed in candidate list for eventual inclusion in Annex XIV of the REACH regulations in a concentration above 0.1%.

According to the specifications of the REACH guidelines, we have contacted our critical raw material suppliers and received confirmation that the materials are REACH compliant.
