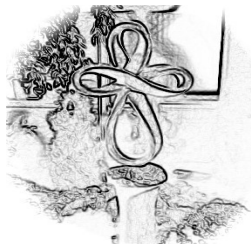

Piano Lessons

Naomi Schimm will again offer beginning through early intermediate piano lessons right here at St. Paul Lutheran School during the 2019-2020 school year, God willing! Eligible students are in grades 3-12; Yes, preteens through high schoolers have their own beginner books! If you have a 2nd-grader who is highly motivated to learn, extra parental support is needed (Naomi will explain). She will meet with students for 30-minute sessions after school ends for the day. The cost is \$12.50 per lesson. Lesson times can be revised as sports seasons or other "specials" get underway. A portion of the income is donated to the school.

Young beginning students can expect to practice for 5-10 minutes per day, 5 days per week. As they progress, their practice time will expand.

Adults, now it's your turn: Learn piano while you wait to pick up your child! Adults actually learn pretty quickly, so don't be afraid to try. Easygoing lessons at your own pace; no recital required.
