

COVID-19: How we're continuing to keep our staff & customers safe

First of all, please accept our thanks for your patience & understanding over the past 18+ months as we all worked together to keep our employees and customers safe.

Effective August 25st, BC health orders have taken a step back in order to get the Delta variant under control.

Face masks Required: BC's health orders again require face masks in retail stores even for people who are fully vaccinated. Disposable masks available if you forget yours. Our staff will continue to wear masks for the foreseeable future.

Feel unwell? If you are showing any cold/flu or COVID symptoms, or have had a recent exposure to anyone with Covid-19 and are not fully vaccinated, please postpone your visit to our stores. Our employees will also stay home if they have symptoms of illness.

Occupancy limits and physical distancing: Our stores no longer have occupancy levels however we kindly ask customers to be mindful of other customers and provide safe physical distancing while in our stores.

Hand sanitizer will be available throughout our stores and we ask that you sanitize your hands before and after handling products or touching high-touch items such as door handles.

Protective plexi barriers: Barriers are one of the most effective means of protecting you and our staff so they will remain in place.

Holding cameras: Please do NOT hold cameras to your face. View screen instead.

Cleaning: We are continuing with our frequent cleanings of counters and high-touch areas as we have done for the past year using our detailed Cleaning Checklist. Employees are also continuing frequent hand washing or use of hand sanitizer.

Ventilation: All of our stores have HVAC systems that are well-maintained to ensure adequate fresh air changes in our stores.

Shop online: Free shipping (on most items over \$99) or pick-up in store. www.kerrisdalecameras.com. Most orders will be shipped or ready for pickup on same or next business day.

Our safety plan: We have transitioned from our COVID-19 Safety Plan and our pandemic policies to a new Communicable Disease Prevention Plan, in consultation with our employees and in compliance with WorkSafeBC.
