Facing Our Fears

2 TIMOTHY 1:7 (ESV) For God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control.

Courage. It's a necessity if we're going to follow Christ and be Fully Alive in a fallen world. In these precarious days of the Coronavirus outbreak, the need for courage has been amplified. In light of this global pandemic, we are presented with an extraordinary opportunity to lean into the strength of Jesus, to confidently experience His hope and peace, and to lovingly engage in the lives of those around us who are grappling with fear and the unknown. But walking that path will require our courage.

Last weekend, looking at John 10 in our Awaken series, we talked about Christ as our Good Shepherd, referencing Psalm 23:4: "Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me." As His followers, we have the privilege and responsibility to ultimately trust in His protection ("rod") and His provision ("staff"). Our security is not based on having our circumstances free of darkness or difficulty, but instead, our confidence is to be anchored in His love, power, and sovereignty. That is what enables us to live, with courage, above our fears.

It is that same security of Jesus that Paul reminds us of when he exhorts Timothy—and us—with a bold reminder that God has not given us a spirit of fear, but one of power...and love...and wise discretion.

We pray this epidemic will subside, and that we all can return to normalcy–overwhelmed with gratefulness for our health and Life as a gift from your hand.

We pray for all who panic, who are overwhelmed with fear—for peace to reign at this time. We pray for all who experience material damage and loss—may they lean into You, trusting You as their provider.

We pray for this to be a moment in history where many turn to Your mercy and grace-may Your glory shine in this moment of our human history.
