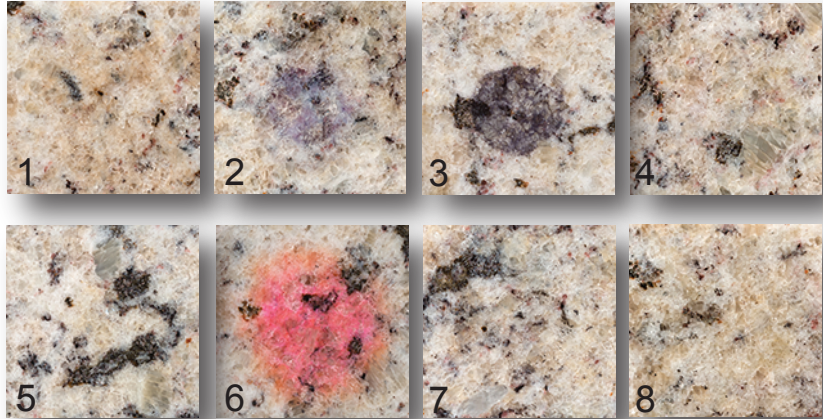
THREE ROUNDS AGAINST BOTH GRANITE AND WOOD

STAIN TEST

For testing, 3-4 drops (liquids), or the spot about the size of a nickel (marker/crayon), were placed on the surface of the test panel. All but the tea bag were covered with a 1" watch glass. Staining material were left in place for 16-24 hours, and then cleaned per NEMA test method instructions including: flushing with water, wiping with commercially available cleaner and a cellulose sponge, repeating with the addition of baking soda to form a paste, rubbing with a cotton ball saturated with acetone, and finally, finishing with a cotton ball saturated in bleach for two minutes.
