



## **READY for a CONVOY?**

The success of the 2009 TMC'09 cross-country convoy project and its predecessor, the 1992 ALCAN Convoy project made it abundantly clear to the Military Vehicle Preservation Association (MVPA) ([www.mvpa.org](http://www.mvpa.org)), that these events are one key way to present the MVPA and our hobby to a large number of the public, as well as all levels of government and business organizations.

Thus, a “Rolling 10-year Convoy” plan has been prepared, and to begin with, this plan proposes the following convoy projects (each, up to a month long):

**2009 – TMC'09 ... retracing the 1919 US Army Transcontinental Motor Convoy, from Washington, D.C. to San Francisco, CA. COMPLETED.**

**2012 – AC'12 ... traveling the ALASKA Highway, in celebration of the 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary of this important WWII military supply route from the “lower 48” of the US to Alaska.**

**2015 – “retrace the Bankhead route” ... retrace the US Army’s *second* Transcontinental Motor Convoy, completed in 1920. This 3,600+ mile route left from the same location as the 1919 Convoy and travels from Washington, D.C. to San Diego, CA.**

**2017 – Route 66 ... travel along another militarily significant WWII supply route, from Chicago, IL to Los Angeles, CA.**

**2019 – TMC’19 ... celebrate the centennial of the 1919 US Army Transcontinental Motor Convoy route from Washington, D.C. to San Francisco, CA.**
