Start your morning with a complimentary breakfast at one of Plattsburgh's many hospitable lodging properties.

Make your way South to Peru, NY where you'll find Baggs' Landing Paddlesports Centre. Baggs Landing is The Kayak Shack's main location for rentals, tours and instructional programs open from Memorial Day to Labor Day. It offers unparalleled opportunities to paddleboard or kayak 45 minutes along the protected waterways of the Ausable River to the mouth where it meets with Lake Champlain, Ausable Point State Park and the incredible views of the Green Mountains of Vermont. From yoga lessons on the paddleboards to moonlit tours along the river, Baggs Landing can customize your group's time on the water and make it a memorable experience on the Adirondack Coast. kayak-shack.com

After the park, you need the pub. Stop by Livingoods Restaurant and Brewery in Peru, NY to grab a delicious, farm to table meal and a tasting of their locally inspired craft brews. Reserve The Great Room for your group and enjoy a private, more laid back atmosphere to enjoy your sampling session. *livingoodsrestaurant.com*

Make sure to stop by Rulfs Orchard. Enjoy the apple blossoms in the spring, pick your own strawberries or blueberries in the summer, catch a wagon ride to the pumpkin patch in the fall or book a pie making session for your group to concoct delicious mini apple pie; something Rulfs is known for! Fun Fact: Clinton County is the 2nd largest producer of McIntosh apples in the United States! rulfsorchard.com

If you have some time, take the opportunity to explore Ausable Chasm. With an adventure trail, rafting, rock climbing or just a casual walk around the rim of the chasm to check out the waterfalls and prehistoric rock formations, Ausable Chasm is sure to fulfill your group's adventurous side. ausablechasm.com

Day 2:

Start off the day with a complimentary breakfast!

Expand on the night before and head on over to **Museum Campus** on the historic Plattsburgh Air Force Base. Here your group can spread out and leisurely enjoy the 4 museums located in this one area. The Clinton County Historical Museum, the Champlain Valley Transportation Museum, the Battle of Plattsburgh Museum and the Air Force Base Museum all share different accounts of Plattsburgh's unique story.

Or just take a walk. Follow the mile and a half long bike path along Lake Champlain, take the footbridge down to a secluded beach or leisurely walk around the U.S. Oval past historic buildings.

In this same area you'll see a building known as the Old Stone Barracks, which has served a variety of military related purposes since its erection in 1838. After years of sitting untouched, the Barracks was bought by **Valcour Brewing Company** and is being brought back to life in the form of a brewery, restaurant and inn. Opening this spring, your group can tour the barracks, hear the stories of its past and taste the history with samples of their craft brews. *valcourbrewery.com*

Grab a growler to go and head up to Point Au Roche State Park where lunch from **Conroy's Organics** will be waiting for you beneath the pavilion. Conroy's is a natural, organic and local foods market that specializes in the finest, freshest products; your lunch will not disappoint! *conroysorganics.com*

After lunch, spread out and enjoy the beauty of the State Park. With nature trails twisting and turning throughout the park, Lake Champlain in front of you and a beach to simply just relax on, Point Au Roche offers plenty of opportunities for your group to enjoy (bikes, kayaks and paddleboards can be rented from local businesses for your group to take advantage of).

Before getting back on Interstate 87 to head home, stop by Elfs Farm Winery and Adirondack Cider Company. Here you can pick up a souvenir bottle of wine or hard cider made from locally harvested products. If you have time, do a tasting of these delicious products and enjoy the fun atmosphere set by the Frey family. elfsfarm.com
