AMBULATORY EXPERIENCES FOR SUMMA Internal Medicine Clerkship

1. Schedule Clinic

Each student is paired with one resident with whom they work on the Medical Inpatient Teaching Service.

- The student completes half-day ambulatory experiences with that resident during the residents Ambulatory Clinic.
- There is never more than 1 student with a resident and no more than 2 students in the IMC at any given time.

2. Patient Follow Ups

- Each student is given an opportunity to be present and involved in the follow up of at least 2 patients for whom they provided care during the patients stay in the hospital.
- The amount of contact for each student will vary but at least two patients will be seen.

3) HIV Ambulatory Center (CARE Center):

 The student that requests to rotate on the Infectious Disease Subspecialty Service will be scheduled for half-day ambulatory experience in the CARE Center with a board certified internist who specializes in the ambulatory care of HIV patients.

Please note that the above experiences should not conflict with scheduled lectures and commitments previously scheduled with your Clerkship.
