

Admission Cap Rules

ACGME Admission Cap Rules

- 5 new patients per day for a PGY-1
 - This includes all admissions and floor consults
- 10 new patients per day for a senior (PGY-2 or PGY-3)
 - This includes all admissions and floor consults
- 14 total patients per day can be seen by a team with 1 senior and 1 intern
 - This includes new admissions, floor consults and follow-ups
- 20 patients can be seen by a team with 1 senior and 2+ interns
 - This includes new admissions, floor consults and follow-ups

Census cap rules for med team admissions

The med team census will be evaluated at 7AM and 7PM

The census calculation includes all non-ICU/CCU patients and patients without a discharge order

If the total med team census is \leq 45, **all patients will be accepted**

- This includes:
 - o IMC patients
 - IM core faculty patients
 - Unassigned patients
 - Patients without a PCP
 - Patients with a PCP not covered by another inpatient provider/group*

If the total med team census at 7AM or 7PM is > 45:

The AR1 will notify the ED secretary that med team is **only taking IMC/core faculty patients for the next 12 hours**

The ACGME admission cap rules (included above) are **always in effect**

If admission caps are reached, the AR2 will see new admissions

* For example: USACS, SHMG, Bonyo/Amanambu, Kusar, Smith
