**PATIENTS WITH LIFE-THREATENING/EMERGENT NEEDS** should call 911 for assistance. Masks continue to be required for all persons upon entering and while remaining inside Ballinger Memorial Hospital. BMH will continue Medical Screening of patients thru the use of COVID-related questions.

Beginning immediately, inpatients in BMH as well as patients in the Swing Bed/Skilled Nursing Unit may have two designated visitors per day. The two designated visitors must be over the age of 16. The two designated people may both visit the patient that day but must visit at separate times.

In the Emergency Department, no visitors will be allowed in with the patient unless the patient is a minor or is a person who otherwise requires assistance.
