Rules and Regulations for Beaver Mausoleum Crypts and Niches

These rules are supplemental to the General Standards and Regulations on file in the Cemetery Office. Rules and Regulations are subject to change at any time without prior written notice. They are established with the intention of ensuring a uniform and dignified respect for all interments at Beaver Mausoleum. Beaver Cemetery is not liable for any theft or vandalism of any floral tribute or personal item left in the Mausoleum. Any and all non-conforming or unsightly floral arrangements or decorations may be removed and discarded at any time by the maintenance staff or management of Beaver Cemetery and Mausoleum. In order to insure proper care and assure the continued beauty and dignity of the Beaver Mausoleum, we ask that you observe the following regulations and guidelines:

- 1. Floral tributes shall be restricted to cut natural flower arrangements or silk arrangements. No other artificial arrangements or objects are permitted. Fresh cut flowers are permitted at anytime for placement on the tribute tables and must be in a vase.
- 2. Due to limited space, please place only one tribute vase per crypt or niche front on the tribute tables provided. No tributes are permitted to be placed on the floor. Any unsightly or nonconforming tributes or objects will be removed and discarded.
- 3. Potted plants shall be permitted for one week before and one week after only at Christmas and at Easter. Please place a mat or saucer under the pot so that water or soil will not damage the tribute table and create a problem that would cause the management to discontinue this policy.
- 4. All inscriptions and symbols appearing on the front of crypts and niches shall be pre-approved and installed by Beaver Cemetery management. No other items may be affixed to or suspended from a crypt or niche front. They will be removed and discarded.
- 5. Smoking is not permitted anywhere inside the Beaver Mausoleum building.
- 6. A Directory is located inside the main entrance of the Chapel to assist you in locating the crypts or niches of friends and relatives.
- 7. You are encouraged to use the Chapel for meditation or to visit with others. We do request that you leave the Chapel during a funeral service.
- 8. Parking is available at the front and to the side of the Mausoleum building. Please use the side parking area when a funeral is scheduled.
- 9. Children under 15 years of age are not permitted in the Mausoleum unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.
