





ConstructSafe 'In-Field' Assessment tool – What's New?

Based on industry feedback, we have taken steps to make the 'In-Field Assessment Tool' more accessible to companies.

What is the In-Field Assessment tool?

Once a worker has passed a ConstructSafe knowledge assessment, they can demonstrate ongoing competency against the theory that they know by completing an In-Field Assessment.

The In-Field Assessment tool provides a record of workers whilst they work, so there is a full picture of competency. It shows that a worker is applying the knowledge identified in a knowledge assessment. By doing this, we can all be confident in a workers competency.

In-Field Assessors need to have successfully completed a ConstructSafe knowledge assessment in the areas that they want to Assess. More importantly, In-Field Assessment allows workers to practically demonstrate their ability.

How does it work?

'In-Field Assessors' use the ConstructSafe App to log observations of people carrying out their normal work. Each record works similarly to a 'safety observation' and should take less than 5 minutes.

In-Field Assessors can assess anyone who has a ConstructSafe profile. This tool can also be applied to augment training and coaching activities. The assessment presents the opportunity to refine how people work to improve health and safety outcomes to operations.

The worker can provide feedback on assessments or assessors in the ConstructSafe App. This helps to maintain the quality and consistency of assessments.

Companies who use the In-Field Assessment tool appoint a Moderator, who oversees the In-Field Assessors within their organisation. This person must pass the ConstructSafe Moderator test to be eligible. They take the test by logging into their company profile, using the online ConstructSafe portal.

ConstructSafe monitors all In-Field Assessments to maintain quality.









Why should my company sign up?

The In-Field Assessment tool is a great way to keep track of your workers and supply chain, removing additional paperwork.

You have instant valuable insight into the work taking place on your construction sites, the In-Field Assessment tool allows you to demonstrate how good your workers are when it comes to health and safety.

How does my company sign up?

You will need details of your workers who have successfully completed a ConstructSafe Trade knowledge assessment. These workers are eligible to be Moderators. Using the ConstructSafe portal, they complete the online test by logging into your company profile. You don't need to use a test centre for the Moderators test.

Your company can then apply to become an Assessment Centre in the portal.
