2024 Fees and Levies Annual Amounts

The College tuition fee includes but is not limited to technology support; provision of an iPad for Years 7 to 9; all compulsory camps, retreats, and excursions; wellbeing support and teaching and learning programs.

The Capital Levy contributes to the College continued commitment to providing the best facilities for our students and community.

The Parents' Association Levy support the functions that are facilitated by the Parents' Association such as the Significant Women's Breakfast.

Discounts

An early settlement discount of \$250 per student will apply if the full years' fees are paid in advance by the nominated date.

A sibling discount of \$350 per student applies for each of the children when attending the College, at the same time.

Curriculum Resources

Other compulsory resources that are not purchased via the College Book List will be charged to your account. This may include electronic resources such as Edrolo, Stile and Language Perfect.

Non-Compulsory Activities including Camps/Trips

The College offers various activities whereby participation is voluntary. Families will be made aware of any costs at the time that the activities are offered.

The students of families receiving fee assistance or having arrears in the current fees will not be permitted to participate in any non-compulsory camps or trips.

General

Accounts are issued at the start of the College year. Accounts may be paid in full, or a payment plan of ten monthly instalments or quarterly instalments may be offered.

For students entering the College for the first time after the beginning of a term, tuition fees are charged on a proportionate basis.

A term's notice is required in writing to the Principal prior to the withdrawal of a student from the College.

Without this notice, a term's fee will be charged.
