## **Covid-19 Home School Agreement**

### **School**

The school will make every effort to

- provide an environment which is risk assessed in line with DfE guidance in response to the Covid-19 pandemic
- adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably and practically can
- provide a curriculum offer that will include a combination of core subjects (English, Maths and Science) plus some option subjects to supplement distance learning
- offer each student with support for their emotional wellbeing
- contact you if your child shows symptoms of Covid-19 whilst they are in our care
- inform you if a member of staff or a child within your child's learning group tests positive for Covid-19 as your household will then have to self-isolate for a period of 14 days
- apply the behaviour policy fairly, including procedures included in the recently published addendum
- continue to communicate with you through our website, emails, text alerts and letters

I, as representative of the school, understand that I have a responsibility to myself and others to enforce all of these expectations.

### **Student**

As a student you will make every effort to

- understand and follow the revised expectations so you play your part in keeping everyone safe from the risks of Covid-19
- follow altered routines for arrival and departure to the site – line up, using the coloured lines at your allocated entrance and meet your teacher. Leave the site when dismissed and maintain the 2m social distancing rules
- maintain a social distance of 2m from your peers and members of staff when lining up, moving around the site and working in your designated classroom
- follow the hand hygiene expectations – using hand sanitiser when you arrive and leave the school building and before leaving the classroom. Always wash your hands after using the toilet facilities
- practice good hand and respiratory (breathing) hygiene in relation to sneezing, coughing, tissues and disposal (in line with the "catch it, bin it, kill it" message) and make every effort to avoiding touching your mouth, nose and eyes
- follow the school's one-way system when moving around the site
- not attempt to gain access to any out of bounds areas of the school
- wear freshly laundered uniform every day (without the tie and blazer)
- only use your allocated stationery and equipment during lessons
- remain at your allocated desk or learning space and ask the member of staff leading if you feel you need to leave my place for any reason

- socialise in your allocated area during social time keeping a 2m distance from people
- only use the allocated toilet facilities for your group
- tell a member of staff if you feel unwell
- not threaten to or deliberately cough, sneeze or spit at another student or member of staff

I understand that I have a responsibility to myself and others to behave sensibly and safely, to show respect to others so that we keep everyone in the academy as safe as possible. If I behave in a dangerous and disrespectful way, I understand that the Principal will make a decision about my future learning at the academy.

## Parents

As a parents/carer I agree to the following

- if my child or anyone in my household has or shows symptoms of Covid-19, I will not send them in to school, we will isolate as a family for a 14-day period. I will ensure my child is tested and contact the school as soon as possible to inform them of the results
- if my child shows symptoms of Covid-19 during their time in school, I will collect them immediately. My child will be tested for the virus and I will contact the school as soon as I have the results
- if I am dropping my child off or collecting them from the school, I will adhere to the timings they have been given for their learning and remain in my vehicle
- ensure their child does not bring any items in to school that are either not necessary or allowed

As a parent/carer I also understand that

- I will only be able to visit the school under exceptional circumstance and not without an appointment
- I have a duty to support the school in ensuring there is the safest possible environment for students and staff
- I will read all communications from the school
- if my child behaves in a way, that compromises the safety and wellbeing of others, that a decision will be made by the Principal in relation to a possible sanction and future arrangements for learning
