We will be: We will be learning about the numbers to 20. During our maths sessions we will be counting, adding and subtracting. We will be solving number problems such as more and fewer by using objects and writing numerals to represent our thinking such as

$$5 + 2 = 7$$

$$6 - 1 = 5$$

Physical Development

Learning to move in a variety of ways with control and skill both indoors and outdoors.

We will be doing whole class PE sessions outside using the large play area. We will use balls, hoops and bean bags.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

We will be:

Learning about planting seeds and bulbs. We will plant a variety of green plants and care for them.

We are looking forward to growing our own vegetables in the outside area. We need to know the parts of the plant such as the stem, leaves, roots and flower.

Language Development

We will be:

Reading and writing

Please make sure that Reading Books are returned to school every day, and that Reading Record books have been completed. We will be using the stories 'Jasper's Beanstalk' and 'Jack and the Beanstalk' to spark our imagination for story.

We are now learning to write sentences - so any opportunity to say and see a sentence written by you is great learning.

In our phonics we are learning the long vowel phonemes such as 'ai, igh, ee oa, oo and or, ar, ow, oi, we will be blending these to read real and nonsense words.
