Our new menus for the remainder of the school year start next week with Week 2 – however, please note we will be serving a special menu on Thursday 5th March for World Book Day.

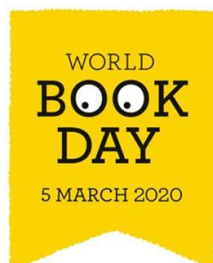
The new menus look really exciting – if your child doesn't usually have school dinners, this would be a good time to encourage them to try the delicious food provided by Catering Leeds.
